Course sequence of ENGL 1101 and ENGL 1102; Been having some problems with students taking this on time due to registration difficulties.

Also there is an issue with too many students coming in with ENGL 1101 AP.

44 sections of ENGL 1101. Most sections of ENGL devoted to ENGL 1102 in the spring.

What happens to students who decide that they are not going to take it now? There is a 30 credit rule on the books. There is a lot of discussion about what this means in regards to ways to enforce it.

Handed out the dates. These are on the website as well and can be shared with others.

FASET registration opens on May 19th at 9am.

April 28th is when summer transfer registration closes.

Will continue to release dates earlier.
