Enid-Math Changes

1501 and 1502 is now 1551, 1552 and 1553

1550 is a 3 hour class for Summer Freshmen that covers some precalc and also the material from 1551.

Summer Freshmen who do not have credit through AP (for example) for 1551 are encouraged to take MATH 1550 in the summer.

MATH 2551, used to be MATH 2401.

MATH 2552, used to be MATH 2403

Also new honors versions of the classes: 2561 and 2562

There are three new linear algebra courses starting Fall 2015: 1553 (2 hours), 1554 (4 hours) and 1564 (4 hours - honors like). 1553 is the old 1522.

How is this changing equivalencies? The registrar is working on this now, so expect an update soon. We will need to know this for FASET.

1550: Summer Freshman would take 1550 in place of 1551. 1550 will only be offered in the summer. It will have more material (such as precalc material) and will be taught every summer.

If a student is starting in the Fall term with no AP credit, the SoM strongly recommends options 1 or 2 from the back of the flyer. Though students could take two, two hour courses in their first semester, this option is not recommended, but may be necessary for students who need to complete MATH 2552 Differential Equations by the end of their second year and are unable to attend summer school.

Rule: No more than four hours of math [1551, 1552, 1553, 1554, 1564, 2551, 2552, 2561, 2562] per semester.

Does 1113 still exist? Yes it does.

What do students have to have in the first 30 hours? Math will be checking on this. It looks like they will have to have 6 hours of Math in the first 30 hours. 1711 and 1712 will still be offered.

Fall and spring there will still be 1502. 1501 will not be offered in the fall. Registrar will work with students that are not going to be here in the fall and spring (such as co-op students).

Will be teaching 1522 in the summer. Will be replaced by 1553 (both are two hours).

1553 is not recommended anywhere on the handout, but it will make sense for many of the students. But take the "*not recommend*" statement with a grain of salt.

What will happen to transfer equivalencies as well as re-admits? The registrar is working on this right now. It will probably be case by case at this point.

Math and the registrar have been dealing with these issues and it will come out in a table/spreadsheet once everything is sorted out/suggestions are made.

1551 is a pre-req for 1552 but not 1553. Some freshman will be fine with 1553.

Physics 1- pre-req is 1551/1552 is a co-req.
