- Welcome Beatrice Hegidio back to Tech as a Learning Specialist/Academic Coach in CAS
- Services available to students – Drop-in Tutoring, PLUS sessions, Academic Coaching
- GT 2100 – Questions GTAAN wanted answered in today's talk:
 - i. What is GT 2100?
 - 1. Course for newly readmitted students
 - a. Section B is for students on academic probation; if a student wants to take GT 2100 and it'll put them above their maximum allowed registration credits, and then they will petition the Registrar. CAS will always say yes as it's a benefit to the students.
 - 2. Handout with GT 2100 schedule for summer & fall will be posted on GTAAN website
 - 3. Statistically speaking if a student will be dismissed it will be in their first semester.
 - ii. How is GT 2100 doing and is it making a difference?
 - 1. Qualitative & quantitative data to inform practice; see handout attached for student success stories
 - 2. Before GT 2100, 14% equaled graduation for readmitted students without any support.
 - 3. Post GT 2100, 46% have graduated; 70% of original cohort were able to continue.
 - 4. Handout for student success and challenges (attached); continuously working to help student navigate school and life, check to see if they have a balanced schedule, sometimes have to have tough conversations.
