VOICE is Georgia Tech's sexual and relationship violence prevention and response initiative based in the Office of Health Promotion.

- If you or someone you know has experienced sexual violence, you are not alone. VOICE is here to help!
- Sexual violence serves as an umbrella term for power-based violence that includes sexual harassment, sexual assault, intimate partner or dating violence, and stalking.
- Health Promotion has a **health educator** and two **victim-survivor advocates** who coordinate VOICE. The advocates are available **24/7** for immediate **confidential support** for all Georgia Tech students. They can also connect students with resources if they are struggling with classes, personal safety, or other consequences resulting from their experience.
